## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On April 2, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) its 2018 Integrated Resource Plan, which is required by the Commission’s Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. On April 4, 2018, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the application and setting a deadline of April 25, 2018 for persons requesting to intervene in this matter.

Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy, Midwest Energy Consumers Group, Sierra Club, Natural Resources Defense Council, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri, and Dogwood Energy, LLC filed timely applications to intervene. Ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the applications to intervene.<sup>1</sup> The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The application to intervene filed by Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy is granted.

<sup>1</sup> Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) provides that parties shall be allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. The application to intervene filed by Midwest Energy Consumers Group is granted.
3. The application to intervene filed by Sierra Club is granted.
4. The application to intervene filed by Natural Resources Defense Council is granted.
5. The application to intervene filed by National Association for the Advancement of Colored People is granted.
6. The application to intervene filed by Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission is granted.
7. The application to intervene filed by Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri is granted.
8. The application to intervene filed by Dogwood Energy, LLC is granted.
9. This order shall be effective when issued.

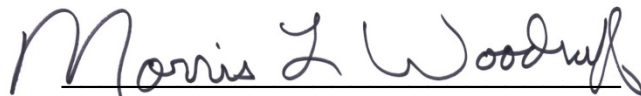
