On October 29, 2020, Evergy Metro, Inc. and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. (referenced together as “Evergy”)¹ filed its Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule. Evergy requests the procedural schedule in this matter be suspended in order to accommodate the parties’ settlement discussions. Evergy states that they will inform the Commission of the status of their negotiations no later than December 4, 2020.

Counsel for Evergy represented that no parties object to this request. Based on the representation of counsel, the Commission will consider the request unopposed.

The Commission finds the unopposed motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. The procedural deadlines and dates set for proceedings, including the evidentiary hearing set on November 5-6, 2020, are canceled.
3. The parties shall file a status report no later than December 4, 2020.
