AMEREN MISSOURI'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION OF ORDER REGARDING OBJECTIONS AND MOTION TO STRIKE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") and hereby seeks clarification with respect to one Exhibit that was the subject of its Objections and Motion to Strike, but which was not addressed in the Commission's *Order Regarding Objections and Motion to Strike* (the "Order"). In this regard, Ameren Missouri states as follows:

- 1. The Order sustained Ameren Missouri's objection on hearsay grounds to the newspaper articles contained Exhibit I, including a <u>St. Louis Post-Dispatch</u> article entitled *Leaks* from the Ameren Toxic Waste Pond in Labadie Stirs Fears.
- 2. That same article was submitted as Exhibit M. Ameren objected to Exhibit M on the same bases as its objections to Exhibit I, including on hearsay grounds, at page 16 in footnote 16 of its original Objections and Motion to Strike. The Commission appears to have overlooked the objection to Exhibit M, perhaps because it was addressed in a footnote.

3. For the reasons given in the Order, Exhibit M is inadmissible hearsay. Ameren Missouri's objection thereto should be sustained and it too should be ordered stricken from the record.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri prays that the Commission make and enter and order Order clarifying that its objection on hearsay grounds to Exhibit M is sustained, and that Exhibit M is stricken from the record.
