**ORDER APPROVING REVISED TECHNICAL RESOURCE
MANUAL AND DEEMED SAVINGS TABLE AND GRANTING
EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Effective Date: October 9, 2021

On December 5, 2018, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement in this case, which, among other things required Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) to file an updated Technical Resource Manual (TRM), and an updated Deemed Savings Table. The Commission approved revised TRMs and Deemed Savings Tables on February 27, 2019, December 11, 2019, July 8, 2020, and November 12, 2020. On September 15, 2021, Ameren Missouri filed additional revisions to the TRM and Deemed Savings Table. Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission approve those changes no later than October 15, 2021, so that they can go into effect at the beginning of the next program year on January 1, 2022.

Ameren Missouri explains that the primary purpose of this update is to incorporate Evaluation Measurement & Verification (EM&V) results from the 2020 program year. In addition, this revision also includes minor modifications to align the TRM measures within the Deemed Savings Tables to current planned program offerings. The changes also include various formatting and terminology "clean-up" items. Attachment 1 to the request includes a description of these changes and the rationale for each change.

Ameren Missouri reports that the Staff of the Commission had no concerns with those changes. The Commission directed any responses to the request be filed no later than September 24, 2021, and no responses were received.

The Commission has reviewed Ameren Missouri's request and determines that the revised TRM and Deemed Savings Table are in compliance with the Commission's December 5, 2018 order. The Commission will approve the revisions to become effective on January 1, 2022. Additionally, because of the need to update relevant data tracking and reporting systems by January 1, 2022, to align the program tracking data with the program evaluation, the Commission will grant the motion for expedited treatment and make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Request to Revise Technical Resource Manual and Deemed Savings Table and Motion for Expedited Treatment* is granted.
2. The revised Technical Resource Manual and Deemed Savings Table filed by Ameren Missouri on September 15, 2021, are approved to become effective on January 1, 2022.
3. This order is effective on October 9, 2021.
