On March 27, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri applied to the Commission for approval of a Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) plan. The Commission convened a prehearing conference for the parties to discuss scheduling.

On May 22, 2023, the parties filed a Joint Status Report (Report). In the Report, the parties explain that they will hold further technical conferences. Thus, the parties believe they can file a procedural schedule or status report by June 20, 2023.

The Commission finds the request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file a procedural schedule or a status report no later than June 20, 2023.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
