On March 27, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri applied to the Commission for approval of a Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) plan. The Commission convened a prehearing conference for the parties to discuss scheduling.

On June 20, 2023, the parties filed a Joint Status Report (Report). In the Report, the parties explained that they are discussing avenues for Ameren Missouri to continue its current MEEIA plan into 2024. The parties believe they can file a status report by July 10, 2023.

The Commission finds the request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file a status report no later than July 10, 2023.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
