- 9 it for a smooth transition?
- MR. BLANC: Precisely.
- 11 JUDGE JONES: Does anyone foresee a problem
- 12 with that deadline?
- 13 (No response.)
- 14 JUDGE JONES: Hearing none. Other than
- 15 that, I don't have anything else. You-all can -- does
- 16 anyone have anything we need to discuss on the record, any
- 17 concerns of any kind?
- 18 I don't hear anything, so with that we'll
- 19 go ahead and go off the record and I'll leave you-all to
- 20 discuss any agreement you might come to. Thank you.
