The Missouri Public Service Commission is giving notice of this action, directing Staff to file a recommendation, and setting deadlines for other filings.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to:

a. Each party and amicus in File Nos. ER-2012-0174 and ER-2012-0175;

and

b. The county commission of each county in the service areas of Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("applicants").

2. The Missouri Public Service Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the residents of applicants' service area and to the news media serving those residents.

3. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than April 30, 2012.

4. Any response to any application for intervention shall be filed no later than

May 9, 2012.

5. No later than May 11, 2012, the Commission's staff shall file a recommendation on the application.

6. Applicant and the Office of the Public Counsel shall, and any other party may, file a response to the recommendation no later than May 21, 2012.
