On April 13, 2012¹, Nickie Hertzog filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that her electric supplier be changed from Osage Valley Electric Cooperative ("Osage Valley") to Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L").² The Commission made Osage Valley a party. Both Osage Valley and the Staff of the Commission oppose her request.

Thus, the Commission set a prehearing conference for September 11, at 10:00 a.m., to give the parties the chance to discuss, define, and possibly resolve the issues presented. On August 28, citing a conflict, Osage Valley requested the Commission move the conference to 1:30 p.m. The Commission allowed parties until September 4 to object. The Commission received no objections.
