On April 13, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed its List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination. On April 14, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a similar document. The proposed issues lists and proposed schedules for witness testimony are similar but not identical. In fact, the Staff's list of issues contains some issues not contained in the GMO pleading. Because the Staff's witness schedule contains some witness conflict dates that were presumably not available to GMO, the Commission will adopt Staff's order of witnesses.

It should be clear, however, that the lists of issues submitted by the parties merely serve as a guide and as a structure for adducing testimony. The parties' framing of the issues may not accurately reflect the material issues to this matter under the applicable statutes and rules, and the parties may not have included all of the issues that the Commission finds material to its final decision.

The hearing process is dynamic and fluid and changes to this schedule will be made during the evidentiary hearing. The Commission shall set the following schedule for the

appearance of witnesses.¹ Witnesses listed on the schedule below shall appear on the days listed unless changes have been authorized by the Commission.
