**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE EXPEDITED
RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR OTHER
PARTIES TO OFFER RECOMMENDATIONS**

On May 28, 2010, the Commission issued a report and order that rejected AmerenUE's tariff to increase the company's annual revenues from its provision of electric service. However, that report and order authorized AmerenUE to file a tariff sufficient to recover revenues as determined by the Commission in that report and order. AmerenUE filed its compliance tariff on June 8.

AmerenUE's compliance tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on July 8, 2010. However, AmerenUE filed a motion along with its tariff asking the Commission to expedite its consideration of the compliance tariff and to approve the tariff to go into effect on June 18, or at latest, on June 21, which is the date to which the Commission had suspended AmerenUE's initial rate increase tariff filing.

The Commission will order its Staff to file an expedited recommendation regarding AmerenUE's compliance tariff, and will establish a date by which other interested parties may file a recommendation regarding that tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's compliance tariff, Tariff No. YE-2010-0697, no later than June 14, 2010.
2. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's compliance tariff, Tariff No. YE-2010-0697, shall do so no later than June 14, 2010.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
