ORDER RESCHEDULING MEXICO LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

The Commission postponed its January 7, 2010 local public hearing in Mexico due to adverse weather. On January 13, the Commission rescheduled that hearing for January 28. Unfortunately, because of a scheduling conflict with another event at Mexico High School, that local public hearing must once again be rescheduled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on Monday, February 1, 2010, from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., or until all persons who wish to testify have done so, whichever is sooner, at Mexico High School – Emmons Hall, 639 North Wade, Mexico Missouri 65265.

2. The local public hearing shall be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of Audrain County.

4. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to members of the General Assembly and to the media that serve the affected portion of Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's service area.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
