STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEET

- 1. On October 1, 2009, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") filed one (1) tariff sheet with the Commission bearing a proposed effective date of December 1, 2009. With the tariff sheet Empire proposes to revise the Cost Adjustment Factor (CAF) of its Fuel Adjustment Clause the Commission approved as part of its *Report and Order* in Case No. ER-2008-0093 from the first revised CAF value of \$0.00081 to a negative \$0.00037 per kilowatt hour. By means of this proposed change in the CAF Empire requests an decrease in the revenues it bills through its fuel adjustment clause of \$820,443.

On October 1, 2009, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed with the Commission one (1) tariff sheet bearing a proposed effective date of December 1, 2009 to revise the Cost Adjustment Factor (CAF) of its Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC). By means of the proposed tariff sheet Empire requests a decrease of \$820,443 in the revenues it bills through its FAC by decreasing the CAF from \$0.00081 to \$(0.00037) per kilowatt hour. On October 27, 2009, Empire filed a substitute tariff sheet to correct two dates in the filed tariff sheet, as requested by the Commission's Energy Department Staff (Staff).

The Energy Resource Analysis Section has reviewed the tariff sheet and the accompanying work papers and has determined that: (1) Empire's calculation satisfies the standards set forth in Schedule FAC's 2nd Revised Sheet No. 17c; (2) Empire is current on its Surveillance Monitoring reports as required by 4 CSR 240-20.090(10); and (3) Empire timely filed its proposed tariff sheet 2nd Revised Sheet No. 17c. The Staff, therefore, recommends to the Commission that it issue an order approving the following proposed tariff sheet, as filed on October 1, 2009, and substituted on October 27, 2009, to become effective on December 1, 2009, as requested by Empire, subject to both true-up and prudence reviews:

On October 1, 2009, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed its proposed 2nd Revised Sheet No. 17c to update the Cost Adjustment Factor (CAF) of its fuel adjustment clause (FAC). This current filing, opening Case No. ER-2010-0105, is in compliance with the 4 CSR 240-3.161 Electric Utility Fuel and Purchased Power Cost Recovery Mechanism Filing and Submission Requirements, § 386.266 RSMo, and the *Report and Order* this Commission issued in Case No. ER-2008-0093. Included in the current filing are the proposed tariff sheet, the testimony of W. Scott Keith of Empire, and workpapers. The workpapers support Empire's calculation of the difference between Empire's actual fuel and purchased power costs and Empire's FAC base costs during Accumulation Period 2 of Empire's FAC – March 2009 through August 2009.

The accumulation periods, recovery periods, and other specifications of Empire's FAC are set out in its tariff sheets designated Schedule FAC Sheets 17 and 17a through 17c, which also describe how Empire is to calculate the CAF for each six-month Recovery Period, in this case Recovery Period 2 – December 2009 through May 2010.

The Energy Resource Analysis Section has performed a review of the data and mathematical calculations that support Empire's proposed update to the CAF, and in particular the values on lines 1 through 11 on the proposed 2nd Revised Sheet No. 17c. The review included examination of the workpapers, testimony, and tariff sheet filed in this case, as well as the monthly monitoring reports and quarterly surveillance monitoring reports applicable to the second accumulation period. The data provided and the mathematical calculations satisfy the definitions and requirements of Empire's Schedule FAC Sheets 17 and 17a through 17c.

Empire is current on its submission of its Surveillance Monitoring reports as required in 4 CSR 240-20.090(10) and its monthly reports as required by 4 CSR 240-3.161(5).
