## NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION AND CORRECTION

Issue Date: May 20, 2010

On May 19, 2010, the Commission issued its Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. On page 2 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph of the order, the Commission states:

If the parties later agree or it is later determined by the Commission that Plum Point is operational by August 15, then the agreed-upon increase in Empire revenue will be \$36,800,000. If Plum Point expenditures are not reflected in rates, then the revenue will be \$23,100,000.

These amounts do not include an additional, agreed-upon \$10,000,000 in amortizations. With the amortizations, the paragraph would read:

If the parties later agree or it is later determined by the Commission that Plum Point is operational by August 15, then the agreed-upon increase in Empire revenue will be \$46,800,000. If Plum Point expenditures are not reflected in rates, then the revenue will be \$33,100,000.

The Commission therefore clarifies its order to include the \$10,000,000 in amortizations.

Also, on page 2, The Empire District Electric Company's initial proposal for the winter season shows rates for the first 600 kWh as being 0.11133. That is incorrect. The corrected amount is 0.1133. Finally, on page 3, the winter season rates for additional kWh,

under the assumption that Plum Point is not operational and used by August 15, is listed as 0.703. This rate is incorrect. The correct amount is .0703.
