On December 1, 2010, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted to the Commission the above-referenced application, pursuant to Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.161 and 240-20.090. The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 20 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for leave to intervene. The Commission notes that per Commission rule, parties in the case establishing the fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this case.

Furthermore, the Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the parties in ER-2010-0036 and upon the county commission of each county in Ameren Missouri's service area. In addition, the Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Ameren Missouri's service area and to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the residents of Ameren Missouri's service area.
