ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR INTERVENTION REQUESTS

On September 27, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 Integrated Resource Plan, as required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 20 CSR 4240-22. The purpose of an Integrated Resource Plan is to ensure investor-owned utilities consider all options, including demand side efficiency and energy management measures, to provide safe, reliable, and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(7) requires the Commission's Staff to review Ameren Missouri's filing and to file a report of its findings not later than 150 days after the utility's scheduled compliance filing date. Subsection (8) of that rule allows the Office of the Public Counsel and other parties to file a report within that same 150 days. Ameren Missouri's plan was due on October 1, 2020 and 150 days after that date is February 28, 2021, which is a Sunday, so the reports are due no later than Monday, March 1, 2021.

The Commission will give notice of Ameren Missouri's filing to potentially interested parties and will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to each party to Ameren Missouri's most recent general rate case, File No. ER-2019-0335.
2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media and members of the General Assembly serving Ameren Missouri's service area.
3. Any entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application no later than October 30, 2020. Applications may be filed with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission or through the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System (EFIS).
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
