ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE FROM ALL APPLICANTS TO INTERVENE

On March 7, 2013, ITC Midsouth L.L.C. responded to the applications to intervene filed by the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission, The Empire District Electric Company, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company. Midsouth challenges the adequacy of the applications and requests the Commission direct those entities to specifically identify the issue or issues related to the limited scope of this proceeding which are of concern to them.

The Commission's rule on intervention requires more than conclusory statements of a potential intervenor as to the reasons for their requested intervention. The Commission will grant the relief requested by Midsouth and direct the prospective intervenors to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than March 11, 2013, the entities with pending applications for intervention shall:

a.) file a more definite statement specifically identifying their interest or interests in these proceedings, which must be different from the general public, and explain,

- with particularity, how that specific interest or interests may be adversely affected by a final order of this Commission, or, in the alternative,
- b.) the entities shall explain, with particularity, how their intervention in this matter would serve the public interest.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
