ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On May 28, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed its 2013 Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan and Report pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100. On July 5, GMO filed a motion to approve a tariff and a motion for expedited treatment. The Commission ordered parties to file responses to the tariff and motion no later than July 30.

On July 30, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff pleads that the press of other business prevents it from meeting the July 30 deadline. Staff asks the Commission to extend Staff’s deadline to respond to July 31.


The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time filed by the Staff of the Commission is granted.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
