ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

On January 17, 2014, Timothy A. Blackwell of the Missouri Attorney General’s Office filed an application to intervene on behalf of the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy. Subsequently, on February 11, Jeremy Knee, Associate General Counsel for the Department of Economic Development entered his appearance on behalf of the Division of Energy. Mr. Blackwell and the Attorney General did not, however, immediately withdraw from representation of the Division of Energy.

On February 20, Mr. Blackwell sent an e-mail indicating that he will no longer be representing the Division of Energy and asking to be removed from the distribution list for this case. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(6) provides that an attorney may withdraw from a case before the Commission only by leave of the Commission. The Commission will treat Mr. Blackwell’s e-mail as a request for leave to withdraw and will grant that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Timothy A. Blackwell’s request for leave to withdraw as counsel for the Missouri Department of Economic Development - Division of Energy is granted.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
