## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO STRIKE CROSS-SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

Issue Date: September 23, 2013 Effective Date: September 23, 2013 On September 19, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to strike the prefiled cross-surrebuttal testimony of Charles H. Norris, which Labadie Environmental Organization (LEO) and Sierra Club filed on September 13. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to expedite its consideration of the motion to strike so that the parties will have time to prepare for the evidentiary hearing scheduled for October 15, 16, and 17. To that end, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to allow other parties until September 24 to respond, and to rule on its motion to strike by September 27.

The Commission will not be able to rule on Ameren Missouri's motion by September 27, as it will not have an agenda meeting to make such a ruling until the following week. However, the Commission will establish a shortened time for other parties to respond to Ameren Missouri's motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Motion to Strike Cross-Surrebuttal Testimony of Charles H. Norris shall do so no later than September 25, 2013.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
