ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO RECLASSIFY PORTION OF PRE-FILED TESTIMONY

On August 30, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to reclassify a portion of an attachment to the pre-filed rebuttal testimony of Staff's witness, John P. Cassidy. The portion of the attachment in question is pages 10 and 11 of Schedule 3. Those pages contain specific locations and cost information relating to alternative waste disposal sites that were disclosed by Ameren Missouri in response to a Staff data request. Ameren Missouri did not originally designate its data request response as highly confidential, but has since determined that the information should have been designated as highly confidential rather than public. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to redesignate the portion of the attachment to Staff's testimony in question as highly confidential.

On September 3, the Commission took immediate steps to protect Ameren Missouri's sensitive information by reclassifying all of John Cassidy's rebuttal testimony as highly confidential. At the same time, the Commission directed its Staff to file a public version of Cassidy's testimony, which Staff did on September 4. The Commission also

allowed interested parties until September 10 to respond to Ameren Missouri's motion to reclassify. No such response has been filed.

The Commission has reviewed Ameren Missouri's unopposed motion and finds it to be reasonable. The Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Motion to Reclassify Portion of Pre-Filed Testimony is granted.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
