## ORDER REGARDING ISSUES, OPENING STATEMENTS, WITNESSES, AND CROSS-EXAMINATION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting forth the sequence of opening statements, witnesses, and cross-examination for the evidentiary hearing on the applications. The applications seek the Commission's permission for:

- Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), to transfer transmission facilities ("lines") to Transource Missouri, LL.C.;
- KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), to transfer lines to Transource Missouri, LL.C.; and
- Transource Missouri, L.L.C. to operate the lines.

On March 27, 2013, Staff filed, on behalf of the parties, a *Joint List of Issues, Order of Witnesses and Order of Cross-Examination, and Order of Opening Statements* ("joint list").
