ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Issue Date: April 12, 2013

Effective Date: April 12, 2013

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the applicants to supplement the application for transfer of assets.¹ The directed filing is necessary for the Commission to meet a statutory duty. The duty is to send information to certain county clerks:

The commission shall send a copy of all **information** obtained by it as to what . . . impact such [transfer] will have on the tax revenues of various political subdivisions **to the county clerk** of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located.²

The clerks noticed are not those of counties where the assets are located, they are those where “any portion” of an “affected”—not “impact[ed]”—political subdivision is located.

An “affected” political subdivision is one where the assets are located.

Any person seeking any order under this subsection authorizing the [transaction described in the application] shall, at the time of application for any such order, file with the commission a statement, [of] any, **impact** such [transaction] will have **on** the tax **revenues of the political subdivisions in which any** [assets described in the application] **are** located. [³]

Such political subdivisions may cross county lines, so portions of an affected political subdivision may lie outside the county where the assets are located. Hence the Commission’s duty is to send information to the clerk of any county, not where an asset is located, but where an affected political subdivision is located.

The application for transfer of assets does not list the counties in which all affected political subdivisions are located, so the Commission will order the applications supplemented.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than April 19, 2013, the applicants shall file a supplement to the applications listing each county in which any part of any affected political subdivision, as described in the body of this order, is located.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
