ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On August 29, 2014, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") filed revised tariff sheets. The Commission issued an order suspending the tariff sheets and setting a deadline for entities to file applications to intervene.

The Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy ("DE") filed a timely application to intervene. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) authorizes the Commission to grant an application to intervene if the party has an interest different from that of the general public which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. DE is a state agency vested with powers and duties by statute that include the authority to plan for future energy needs and energy resource development. DE's interests are different than that of the general public. Furthermore, DE's intervention may serve the public interest.

Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds DE meets the standards set in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application of the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
