RESOLVED, that the President, in conjunction with such loan, is authorized to execute and deliver under corporate seal, which the Secretary is directed to affix and to attest, as many counterparts as advisable of the note, contract, mortgage, and security instruments in substantially the form of the loan documents submitted to this and prior meetings; and

RESOLVED, that the officers and manager are authorized in the name of the Company to execute such instruments, make such payments, and do all such other acts, including apply to the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri for approval of such borrowing and security.
