**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INDICATE WHEN IT CAN FILE A
RECOMMENDATION**

On April 28, 2005, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application for an extension of its authority to enter into interest rate management instruments. KCPL asks that the Commission act on its application by July 31, 2005. The Commission will need to have a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the application. So that it may be aware of progress in this case, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a pleading indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall, no later than May 18, 2005, file a pleading advising the Commission when Staff will be able to file its recommendation regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's application.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2005.
