## **ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On December 27, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") applied for permission to increase from \$635 million to \$1.4 billion the authorization to issue debt securities granted by the Commission in Case No. EF-2005-0498. KCPL further requested that the Commission issue an order granting its request by March 1, 2008.

On January 23, 2008, Praxair, Inc. filed an application to intervene in this case. More than ten days have passed since Praxair filed its intervention request, and no party has objected that request.

The Commission finds the interest of Praxair in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Praxair to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Praxair, Inc. is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on February 4, 2008.
