ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On April 24, 2013, Telrite Corporation (“Telrite”) and Applewood Communications Corporation (“Applewood”) (together “Movants”) jointly filed a motion requesting Applewood’s registration to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service (“IVoIP”) in all exchanges in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Applewood’s registration to provide IVoIP services in the State of Missouri in File Number DA-2010-0016.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Movants’ motion is received, the Commission may cancel the registration based on Movants’ motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
