ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On April 24, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that Panasonic Corporation of North America's ("Panasonic") registration to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Panasonic's registration to provide IVoIP services in certain exchanges in the State of Missouri in File Number DA-2011-0411.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the registration based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
