On June 23, 2006, Aquila, Inc. filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission an application as described in the caption of this order.

Proper entities should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to the County Commission of Jackson County, Missouri. Additionally, the Commission's Public Information Office shall send notice of this order to the publisher of each newspaper located in Jackson County, Missouri, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current *Official Manual of the State of Missouri,* and to the members of the General Assembly representing Jackson County, Missouri.

Those wishing to intervene shall file an application to do so with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Copies of the application to intervene must also be sent to the parties listed below.

In light of the Commission's prior grant of authority to Aquila, in Case Nos. 9470 (1938) and 11,892 (1950), the Commission questions whether Aquila needs to presently

seek Commission authority to construct the proposed substation. The Commission will therefore require both Aquila and the Staff of the Commission to address this issue soon after the date for intervention has passed. If Staff is of the opinion that Aquila does need present Commission approval for the requested relief, the Commission will require Staff to file its memorandum recommending approval or rejection of the application through a separate filing. The Commission will also invite the Office of the Public Counsel to file a pleading addressing this issue.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Data Center and the Public Information Office of the Missouri Public

Service Commission are directed to provide notice as described in this order.

4. The Office of the Public Counsel may file, no later than July 18, 2006, a memorandum addressing the issue of whether it is necessary for Aquila, Inc., in light of the Commission's prior grant of authority, to presently seek from the Commission the requested relief.

5. If the Staff of the Commission opines that Aquila, Inc. does need Commission approval for the relief Aquila now seeks, then Staff shall file a memorandum recommending approval or rejection of the application.

6. This order shall become effective on June 28, 2006.
