On January 25, 2006, Aquila, Inc., applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a certificate of convenience and necessity for its already-built South Harper Facility and Peculiar Substation in Cass County, Missouri. In its pleadings, Aquila has referred to a January 27, 2006 hearing at the Circuit Court of Cass County in Case No. CV104-1443CC. Aquila and other parties have referred to an order from that court that extended the effective date of the injunction against Aquila until May 31, 2006.

The Commission will order Aquila to file a copy of the above-mentioned court order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Aquila, Inc., shall file a copy of the order described above no later than April 14, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on April 7, 2006.
