MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy (MGE or Applicant), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rules 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) and 4 CSR 240-2.065(2), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MGE's tariff filed on September 2, 2010:

1. On this date MGE has withdrawn the filing made under Tracking No. JG-2011-0051 and filed new tariff sheets under Tracking No. YG-2011-0115. The YG-2011-0115 tariff filing makes all rebates available to both the Residential (RS) and the Small General Service (SGS) class of customers, but does not change the level of the rebates. MGE believes that the provisions of these tariff sheets were agreed to by the MGE Energy Efficiency Collaborative (EEC).

2. The subject tariff sheets are attached hereto as **Appendix A** and **Appendix B**. They contain a proposed effective date of September 2, 2010, and a proposed effective date of October 2, 2010 (30 days).

3. MGE seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect as soon as practicable.

4. Granting this Motion will afford MGE's SGS customers with access to energy efficiency programs which would not otherwise be available. Delaying the implementation of these aspects of the tariff sheets while the parties address the issues

raised by the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) would delay a tariff designed to assist customers. As such, Commission action as requested will be consistent with the public interest.


5. The subject tariff sheets and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after the Commission's suspension of the JG-2011-0049 tariff sheets and the prehearing conference that was held earlier this date.

6. MGE will make a future filing to bring the water heater rebate issue raised by the OPC before the Commission for decision.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, MGE respectfully requests the Commission to grant MGE's Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve MGE's proposed tariff sheets (YG-2011-0115) as soon as practicable.
