ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 15, 2021, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed its 2020 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and 2021 RES Compliance Plan.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(D), the Commission directed the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) to file a report no later than June 1, 2021. On June 1, 2021, Staff filed a request for an extension of time to June 4, 2021. Counsel for Staff represented that Liberty agreed with Staff's request. Staff cited its need to review supplemental filings as its basis for requesting additional time.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's request for an extension of time to file its report is granted. Staff shall submit its report or a status report no later than June 4, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
