CENTRAL JEFFERSON'S APRIL STATUS REPORT

Comes now Central Jefferson County Utilities, Inc. (Company), and, as its April Status Report, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. The Commission's Report and Order in this case, among other things, ordered that Central Jefferson "file a report in this case stating the status of the transactions no later than March 9, 2007, and continuing every 30 days until it has notified the Commission that all the transactions have been completed." Central Jefferson previously filed a Status Report on March 9, 2007.

2. Central Jefferson understands that three contingencies remain concerning the Tri-Party Purchase and Sale Agreement. First, Environmental Management Corporation (EMC), Central Jefferson and the Jefferson County Public Sewer District (Sewer District) continue to work together to address the remaining title issues. Second, Central Jefferson understands that EMC's Phase 1 environmental survey has been completed since the last Status Report and EMC but the report has not yet been received. Third, the Sewer and Water Service Fee Agreement must be amended to address a contingency associated with Aqua Source.

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4. Central Jefferson understands that since the last Status Report the Sewer District has filed its application with the circuit court to obtain permission to operate the Central Jefferson water properties. The hearing concerning that request is scheduled for May 2, 2007.

5. Further, Central Jefferson understands that as of March 21, 2007, the Jefferson County Commission has appointed Diane Shaw (a Raintree Plantation resident who maintains the Raintree Plantation Bulletin Board web site) as a member of the Sewer District Board.

6. Central Jefferson understands that the Sewer and Water Service Fee Agreement has not yet been amended "to ensure that Mr. Kolisch remains in the same position contractually as he does now for receiving his refunds from Central Jefferson's tariffs," as required by Finding of Fact number 90. However, that amendment should be proposed in the near future.

7. Lastly, the attorneys have been working together to prepare all closing documents in advance of the closing in order to speed that part of the process.

WHEREFORE, Central Jefferson asks that the Commission consider this

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Status Report to comply with the Report and Order in this case.
