## ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On July 21, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Staff of the Commission (collectively referred to as "Signatories") filed a *Second Stipulation and Agreement*. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.115(2) provides that parties that are not signatories to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement have seven days in which to object to that agreement. If no party files a timely objection to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement, the Commission may treat it as a unanimous stipulation and agreement. Thus, the Commission will set out the time for responses or objections below.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any responses or objections to the *Second Stipulation and Agreement* filed on July 21, 2020, shall be filed no later than July 28, 2020.
2. This order is effective when issued.
