# ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On April 2, 2018, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") its 2018 Integrated Resource Plan, which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. On April 4, 2018, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the application and setting a deadline of April 25, 2018 for persons requesting to intervene in this matter.
