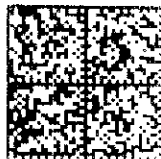

## ORDER REVOKING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: December 13, 2012

Effective Date: December 13, 2012

On November 30, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting N-1 Communications, LLC, d/b/a HiBeam Internet and Voice's ("HiBeam") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri be revoked.

In File Number DA-2010-0319, the Commission granted HiBeam its IVoIP registration in certain exchanges in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that HiBeam is deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report for calendar years 2010 and 2011. In addition, the HiBeam is delinquent in the payment of its fiscal year 2012 and 2013 assessments. Staff recommends that the Commission revoke the company's IVoIP registration.

On November 30, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than December 10, 2012. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

Section 392.550.3(7), RSMo (Supp. 2010) requires Applicants for registration affirm that it "... will file...an annual report at a time and covering the yearly period

fixed by the commission.” The Commission has the authority to revoke the registration pursuant to Section 392.550.4(6), RSMo (Supp. 2010), which states, in part, “...of any provider of interconnected voice over Internet protocol service who fails to comply with the requirements of this section.”

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to N-1 Communications, LLC, d/b/a HiBeam Internet and Voice, shall be revoked.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to N-1 Communications, LLC, d/b/a HiBeam, in File Number DA-2010-0319, is revoked.
2. This order shall become effective on December 23, 2012.
3. This case may be closed on December 24, 2012.
