ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Effective Date: May 19, 2013

On April 24, 2013, Telrite Corporation (“Telrite”) and Applewood Communications Corporation (“Applewood”) filed a motion to cancel Applewood’s registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service (“VoIP”) in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2010-0016, the Commission granted Applewood its statewide VoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Applewood states in its motion that the company has transferred its customers and assets to Telrite. On January 23, 2013, the Commission issued an order approving that transfer in File No. XM-2013-0308. Applewood’s VoIP registration is no longer needed.

On April 26, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than May 6, 2013. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.


The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on Telrite and Applewood's motion, the Commission finds that the VoIP registration granted to Applewood Communications Corporation shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to Applewood Communications Corporation, in File Number DA-2010-0016, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on May 19, 2013.
3. This case may be closed on May 20, 2013.
