ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

On December 7, 2015, Staff filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel New Global Telecom, Inc.'s, ("New Global") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2010-0201, the Commission granted New Global its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that the company notified the Commission that it no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On December 11, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than December 21, 2015. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on New Global's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to New Global Telecom, Inc. shall be canceled.
