## ORDER CANCELING IVOIP REGISTRATION

Issue Date: May 3, 2021 Effective Date: June 2, 2021

On April 20, 2021, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation asking the Commission to cancel the IVoIP Registration of Premiere Hosting, Inc. d/b/a Infiniwiz (Premiere Hosting). The Commission granted Premiere Hosting that Registration in File No. DA-2015-0294, on May 20, 2015.

Staff states in its motion that Premiere Hosting sent a letter to Staff on April 19, 2021, indicating it no longer serves any customers in Missouri and requesting its Registration be cancelled. Staff indicates Premiere Hosting's request to cancel its Registration is in compliance with Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3), and asks the Commission to cancel that Registration.

On April 21, 2021, the Commission issued an *Order Establishing Time to Respond*, allowing parties until April 30, 2021, to object or to request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a Registration pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on the company's request, and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the Registration granted to Premiere Hosting shall be canceled.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Registration to provide IVoIP services granted to Premiere Hosting in File Number DA-2015-0294, is canceled.
