ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: May 9, 2014

Effective Date: May 19, 2014

On April 24, 2014, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel Panasonic Corporation of North America's ("Panasonic") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2011-0411, the Commission granted Panasonic its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Panasonic notified Staff that the company has dissolved its corporate status in Missouri, and no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On April 28, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than May 8, 2014. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on Panasonic's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVolP registration granted to Panasonic Corporation of North America shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol Services granted to Panasonic Corporation of North America, in File Number DA-2011-0304, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on May 19, 2014.
3. This case may be closed on May 20, 2014.
