On July 27, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission opened this case directing the Staff of the Commission to begin a formal investigation of Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE and any other regulated utilities whose activities have an impact on storm restoration efforts concerning the effectiveness of its storm preparation and restoration efforts in Eastern Missouri. On November 17, 2006, Staff filed its report on AmerenUE's storm preparation and restoration efforts.

The Commission will schedule an on-the-record presentation for AmerenUE to respond formally to the recommendations in Staff's Report, to provide the parties an opportunity to provide the Commission with any additional information, and allow the Commissioners the opportunity to ask questions about the response.
