## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR CHANGE IN FILING DATE

On May 11, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the filing date for AmerenUE's next Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) filing from June 1, 2010, to February 5, 2011. AmerenUE contends that since it no longer intends to build a second nuclear unit at the Callaway site, there is no longer any need to expedite its next IRP filing. Because it will need to hire a consultant by the end of this month to begin working on the next IRP filing if the filing date is not extended, AmerenUE asks the Commission to expedite its consideration of its motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Under that standard, any response to AmerenUE's motion would be due on May 21. However, given the need for quick action on the motion, the Commission will shorten the time allowed to file a response to the motion for change in filing date.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's Motion for Change in Integrated Resource Plan Filing Date shall do so no later than May 15, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective on May 11, 2009.
