On July 10, 2023, the parties filed a Joint Status Report (Report). In the Report, the parties explain that they are close to reaching a Stipulation and Agreement to continue its current MEEIA plan into 2024. The parties believe they can file a proposed procedural schedule or a status report by August 16, 2023.

The Commission finds the request reasonable, and will grant it.
