**ORDER GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OR STATUS REPORT**

On March 7, 2022, the Commission issued an order suspending the procedural schedule in these cases, directing Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively “Evergy”) to file a status report no later than April 1, 2022 apprising the Commission whether settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement. Evergy filed a timely status report in response to that order and on April 1, 2022, the Commission issued an order granting an extension of time and directing the parties to file a settlement agreement or a status report advising the Commission whether it believed that ongoing settlement discussions will result in settlement by May 2, 2022. On May 2, 2022, Evergy filed a status report explaining that the parties have been conducting settlement discussions and requesting an extension of time to file a settlement agreement or another status report. Evergy requests until May 23, 2022 to do so.

The Commission finds Evergy's request reasonable and will order Evergy to file a settlement agreement or another status report no later than May 23, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West shall file either a settlement agreement, or another status report apprising the Commission whether settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement, no later than May 23, 2022.
2. This Order shall be effective when issued.
