**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

In reviewing the testimony filed in these cases, the Commission has noted instances in which witnesses have proposed a disallowance, or have referenced a calculation, without including their detailed calculations as a schedule to their testimony. The Commission would like to be able to discern the full basis for those calculations. In particular, at page 11, footnote 10 and page 12, footnote 11 in David Murray’s rebuttal testimony for Public Counsel, the witness describes calculations regarding the spread between traditional corporate debt compared to proposed securitized debt, but cites to his workpapers. Those workpapers are not filed in the record and the Commission does not have access to them. The relevant portion of those workpapers should be filed as attachments to Mr. Murray’s testimony.

Similarly, at pages 4 and 5 of John Robinett’s surrebuttal testimony for Public Counsel, the witness describes his calculation of a disallowance but that description does not clearly set forth the actual calculations. If Mr. Robinett has a more detailed calculation

in his workpapers, the Commission will direct Public Counsel to file it as an attachment to Mr. Robinett's testimony.

The Commission has noted these two instances, but any other witness who has proposed a disallowance, or referenced any calculation in their testimony but has not included their detailed calculation as a schedule to their testimony should do so.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Public Counsel shall file the information described in the body of this order no later than June 9, 2022.
2. Any other party wishing to file additional calculation information in response to this order shall do so no later than June 9, 2022.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
