SUBJECT: Staff's Analysis of and Recommendation Concerning The Empire District

Electric Company d/b/a Liberty Empire's Twenty-Fourth Fuel Adjustment

Clause True-up Filing Under the Provisions in 20 CSR 4240-20.090(9).

On September 30, 2021, The Empire District Electric Company ("Liberty-Empire" or "Company") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), in the form of direct testimony and supporting schedules of Liberty-Empire witness Charlotte T. Emery, its twenty-fourth true-up filing under the provisions of 20 CSR 4240-20.090(9).

Accumulation Period 24 ("AP24") includes the time period March 1, 2020 through August 31, 2020 and is followed by Recovery Period 24 ("RP24"), which includes the billing months of December 2020 through May 2021. The true-up amount of (\$523,943) identified in this filing is the result of an over-collection of the Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment ("FPA") amount for AP24 during RP24.

The true-up amount of (\$523,943) for RP24 is included in the preliminary calculation of the Fuel and Purchased Power ("FPA") amount included in the Company's Accumulation Period 26 ("AP26") adjustment filing, also filed on September 30, 2021, in File No. ER-2022-0095, which Liberty-Empire filed in compliance with its FAC.¹

TRUE-UP OF FPA: In conjunction with an adjustment to its FAR, the Company will make a true-up filing with an adjustment to its FAC on the first Filing Date that occurs after completion of each Recovery Period. The true-up adjustment shall be the difference between the FPA revenues billed and the FPA revenues authorized for collection during the true-up recovery period, i.e. the true-up adjustment. Any true-up adjustments or refunds shall be reflected in item T above and shall include interest calculated as provided for in item I above.

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The Commission Staff ("Staff") examined the direct testimony of Liberty-Empire witness Charlotte T. Emery, the amended direct testimony of Ms. Emery, the supporting schedules and work papers Liberty-Empire provided with its true-up filing in this case, and the monthly information Liberty-Empire has submitted to the Commission. Staff also reviewed and agrees with Liberty-Empire's monthly interest calculations for RP24.

Based on its examination and analysis of information Liberty-Empire filed and submitted in this case, Staff recommends the Commission approve Liberty-Empire's RP24 true-up filing for the billing months December 2020 through May 2021 during which Liberty-Empire over-collected \$523,943 from its customers for inclusion in the calculation of the FPA amount in the Company's AP26 adjustment filing in File No. ER-2022-0095.

Staff has verified that Liberty-Empire has filed its 2020 annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Liberty-Empire is current on its submission of its Surveillance Monitoring reports as required in 20 CSR 4240-20.090(6) and its monthly reports as required by 20 CSR 4240-20.090(5). Staff is not aware of any other matter before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing, except as noted herein.
