The Commission further notes that Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3) allows the Commission to dismiss a case for a party's failure to comply with a Commission order. The Commission notes that according to the reporting parties, Ms. Hertzog has failed to answer e-mails or return phone calls from reporting parties. The Commission will thus explicitly order Ms. Hertzog to join in or object to the October 9 pleading, or risk dismissal of her application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The parties, including Nickie Hertzog, shall file a proposed procedural schedule or another status update no later than October 9, 2012.
2. Nickie Hertzog shall either join in the pleading ordered in paragraph 1, or file a separate pleading, no later than October 9, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
