**APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF OUT OF TIME OF
THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS**

Comes now the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") and, pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-2.075 and the Commission's January 8, 2014 *Order Directing Notice of Application, Establishing Intervention Filing Date, and Scheduling a Procedural Conference*, and pursuant to subsection (10), files its application to intervene out of time. For its application, the MIEC state as follows:

1. The MIEC is a Missouri corporation, and the members of the MIEC are large industrial customers of Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCPL).
2. As large industrial customers of KCPL, the MIEC's interest is different than that of the general public and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from these cases.
3. The MIEC does not yet have a position on the issues in this case and reserves the right to take positions on specific issues as this case proceeds.
4. The MIEC's intervention will serve the public interest by assisting the Commission's record for decision in these cases. The MIEC will accept the record as it stands in this case. This case is at an early stage, and therefore no party will be prejudiced by the MIEC's intervention.

WHEREFORE, the MIEC requests that it be permitted to intervene out of time and be made a party to these cases for all purposes.
