ORDER DIRECTING FILING

In the September 9, 2015 Agenda meeting, Commissioners raised two objections to the non-unanimous stipulation filed in this case by Ameren and other parties on June 30, 2015. Specifically, those objections were the absence of retrospective Evaluation, Measurement and Verification in calculating the throughput disincentive, and the absence of a component of supply side investment reduction in calculating the performance incentive. The Commission will direct the parties to report back whether further negotiations that address those objections could be productive in reaching some agreement on a Cycle 2 MEEIA Plan, and if so, whether the Commission should issue a revised procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than September 16, 2015, the parties shall file a pleading or pleadings stating whether they believe further negotiations could be productive in reaching agreement on a MEEIA plan that addresses the objections discussed in the Commission's September 9, 2015 Agenda meeting. In addition, if the parties intend to engage in further

negotiations, the parties are directed to notify the Commission as to the need to issue a revised procedural schedule.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
